Just a subtle hint of toast and cherry appears on the shy nose. The palate has the same sense of restraint and unfurls its charms of red cherry, subtle spices and vivid freshness only slowly. A fine web of tannin holds it all together to present a most Balanced and subtle Pinot Noir.

An Abundance of red cherry fruit treams from the glass. The same cherry notions, juicy and fresh, also dominate the medium body that has an edge of slightly bitter but mouth-watering liquorice and dranker notion of toasted oak. The finish reverts to that cherry abundance and to juicy freshness.
