Romanée-Saint-Vivant "Les Quatre Joursaux" Grand Cru

"Though packed with black currant, blueberry, and cherry fruit, this red is wrapped up in a firm structure today, giving an austere feel. All the components are in the right proportion and there's no denying the saturated after-taste that echoes the core of cherry."



Clos Vougeot Grand Cru

"This is pure, exuding red and black cherry, earth, mineral and subtle woody notes. Dark and brooding, with excellent balance and length."



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Chambertin "Cuvée Héritiers Latour" Grand Cru

"A compact style, just short of monolithic, displaying black cherry, plum, thyme, graphite and chalk aromas and flavors. Complex and balanced, with a sense of refinement and terrific energy. The best is yet to come. Excellent length."



Charmes-Chambertin Grand Cru

"Floral, macerated cherry and graphite aromas give way to raspberry, spice and violet notes in this concentrated, muscular red. Fleshy and chewy in texture, with ample tannins in reserve. The graphite element pervades from start to finish."
