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Clos Vougeot Grand Cru 2017

A broad-shouldered, fluid red, boasting black cherry, blackberry, pomegranate and iron flavors. Muscular tannins shore up the finish as this plays out. Balanced and long, but angular today. All the pieces are in place for the long haul.



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Echézeaux Grand Cru 2017

A taut, densely woven style, this features black cherry, blackberry, earth and iron flavors, framed by toasty, spicy oak. Muscular but corralled by vivid acidity and mouthcoating tannins.
