VOSNE-ROMANÉE 1ER CRU “LES SUCHOTS”

CORTON-CHARLEMAGNE GRAND CRU

"The 2019 Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru is also quite promising, exhibiting aromas of pear, buttered citrus fruit, honeycomb, toasted almonds and white flowers. Full-bodied, satiny and rich, with a fleshy core of fruit and good underlying freshness, I hope it can repeat this fine performance from bottle."

MONTRACHET GRAND CRU

"The 2019 Montrachet Grand Cru is promising, bursting with notes of pear, white flowers, citrus oil and toasted bread. Full-bodied, ample and layered, it's satiny and concentrated, with fine depth at the core and chalky grip on the finish."

BÂTARD-MONTRACHET GRAND CRU "CLOS POIRIER"

"The 2019 Bâtard-Montrachet Clos Poirier Grand Cru is turning out nicely, exhibiting aromas of pear, toasted nuts, orange oil and popcorn, followed by a full-bodied, layered and nicely concentrated palate. Though the vines here are still young, this appears to be a fine effort in the making."

CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU "LA GRANDE MONTAGNE"

"The 2019 Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru La Grande Montagne mingles notes of pear, toasted nuts, citrus and smoke in an inviting bouquet. Medium to full-bodied, textural and fleshy, with good depth and mid-palate amplitude, this is one of the more promising whites in the range."

Full-bodied, satiny and textural, it's rich and expressive, with lively acids and a charming, demonstrative personality."

"The 2018 Corton Clos du Roi Grand Cru is showing well, offering up aromas of raspberries, spices, rose petals and rich soil tones. Medium to full-bodied, layered and enveloping, it's rich but lively, with velvety tannins and a generous core of fruit."
