2017 Louis Latour 1er Cru and Grand Cru

Clos Vougeot Grand Cru

“A broad-shouldered, fluid red, boasting black cherry, blackberry, pomegranate and iron flavors. Muscular tannins shore up the finish as this plays out. Balanced and long, but angular today. All the pieces are in place for the long haul.”

Romanée-Saint-Vivant Grand Cru

“Les Quatre Journaux”

“Fine purity accents the cherry, strawberry, cinnamon and toast aromas and flavors. Concentrated and fluid, with a supple texture and intensity that builds to a lingering finish. Terrific length.”

Echézeaux Grand Cru

“A taut, densely woven style, this features black cherry, blackberry, earth and iron flavors, framed by toasty, spicy oak. Muscular but corralled by vivid acidity and mouthcoating tannins.”

Château Corton Grancey Grand Cru

“Opulent, silky and fluid, this offers cherry, raspberry, floral, mineral and spice aromas and flavors, well-defined by a lively structure. A slightly chewy intensity allows this to fan out on the juicy finish.”

Aloxe-Corton 1er Cru “Les Chaillots”

“A rich, supple texture sets the stage for cherry, currant, spice and earth flavors. The bright acidity keeps this moving, but this lacks the intensity of its peers.”

Vosne-Romanée

"Pretty, offering black cherry, violet and spice flavors on a polished, open-knit texture. Balanced and enjoyable now, but there is no rush."

Savigny-les-Beaune

"Rich, with cherry, raspberry, spice and earth aromas and flavors. Reveals a tangy quality, in part due to the vibrant acidity. Shows fine balance and length."

Chambolle-Musigny

"Silky and elegant, delivering black cherry, black currant, spice and mineral notes. Balanced and fresh, with fruit and mineral details echoing on the finish."

Nuits-Saint-Georges

"A hard edge clips the cherry, strawberry and earth flavors, accentuated by a graphite note. On the austere side today, this is linear and taut, leaving a chalky, stony impression on the finish."

Marsannay

"A touch earthy on the nose initially but this blows off, revealing ripe black cherry, plum, earth and stone flavors. Rich and balanced, with firm tannins and a mouthwatering finish."
