Louis Latour Pouilly-Fuisse 2015

This great French white wine is a great food wine and offers up aromas and flavors of lemons, peaches, grapefruit and has mineral notes that add to the complexity.

It would be perfect with seafood or chicken in a cream sauce.

It should cost about \$30.
