9 Stellar Chardonnays From Around the World to Buy Now

Searching the globe for incredible expressions of this sometimes divisive grape.

Best Overall Chardonnay: Louis Latour 2022 Corton-Charlemagne Burgundy



The [Latour](#) family owns 25 acres of prime Corton-Charlemagne vineyards on the slopes of the Corton hill making them the largest owner of vines in the appellation. Their average vine has 30 years of age and is planted in stony limestone soils. During harvest the grapes are hand-picked and then fermented in traditional oak barrels with complete malolactic fermentation before the wine is transferred to 100 percent new French oak barrels for 10 months of aging. Bright golden yellow in the glass, this remarkable wine has intense aromas of white honeysuckle, toasted brioche, vanilla, and citrus blossom that transfer seamlessly to the palate for rich flavors and voluptuous mouthfeel followed by a lingering note of acacia honey in the finish.
