



Corton-Perrières

Corton Grand Cru Perrières

Quite lively and spicy on the palate, wrapped in its velevety substance with hints of liquorice.



Vosne-Romanée 1er Cru Les Suchots

On the palate this is massive, dense and opulent showing lots of ripe, voluminous fruit. It has a long but rather thick finish.



Chambertin Grand Cru Cuvée Héritiers Latour

Bottled in November 2021, this is full-bodied and powerful, showing good volume and power with hints of liquorice. Its acidity helps to show its nuances, marking its terroir. It will need some time to refine.



Chambolle-Musigny 1er Cru Les Chatelots

This fairly vigourous wine has already been bottled. Well constructed and smooth, it shows nicely ripe fruit, a bit on the sweet side. The finish seems rather warm and lacking in freshness.



Beaune 1er Cru Vignes Franches

This shows a broad spread and lively fruit dominated by raspberries in an intense and acidulous style.





Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru

Over ten hectares of in-house vineyards are the source of this ripe and supple wine. The flavours are juicy and savoury, revealing notes of almonds, honey and nougat. Robust, with plenty of substance and an almost tannic, chalky finish. This will clearly age well.



Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru Clos Poirier

The nose reveals spice and toast, yellow fruit and curry. The palate is rich and unctuous, with flavours of pears. It assumes its natural opulence, warm and generous. We liked its persistence showing hints of spice and aniseed.



Chevalier-Montrachet Grand Cru Les Demoiselles

This was bottled in November 2021. The nose shows acacia and vine flowers and the palate has quite a fat, dense feeling with plenty of volume and power to its concentrated, full-bodied nature. It is balanced despite its 14% alcohol. The finish is dense and saline.



Beaune 1er Cru Aux Cras

Bottled in September 2021, this from the first plot to be picked. Volume, depth and lemon-like freshness are preserved in this ripe wine that shows a hint of pastry on the finish.



Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru La Grande Montagne

The texture is fine and the palate reveals notes of acacia flower. This is a ripe but energetic wine that is honest and crisp, if not very complex.
