**CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET
1ER CRU "MORGEOT"**

A refined and elegant nose reveals **fresh apple flesh, white rose, and soft ocean breeze aromas**. The palate is understated yet powerful—round, dynamic, and layered with **salted pear, wild flowers, salted almonds, butter, and fine vanilla**. There's a quiet grace to this wine, though more of its character is still to come. Approachable now, but it should show best after another 3–5 years in bottle.

**CHÂTEAU CORTON
GRANCEY GRAND CRU**

Deep ruby in hue, this expression unveils a complex bouquet of **blackberry, pepper, sage, and earthy undergrowth**, evolving into a delicate concentration of **wild strawberries and sweet spice**. Rich and structured on the palate, it layers **wild strawberry, cherry, and a hint of licorice** that persists through its long and vibrant finish. Cellar through 2045+.

**BEAUNE-PERRIERES
1ER CRU**

The nose is deep, revealing **black cherries, boysenberry, licorice, violets, and sweet oak spice**. On the palate, it's textured and round, with subtle layers of **black tea and rose**, followed by **dark fruit, oak spice, and mocha** on the finish. Offering much evolution before full integration, but it's already brimming with promise.

**CORTON-CHARLEMAGNE
GRAND CRU**

A vibrant floral bouquet leads, with freshly peeled **red apple skin, toasted almonds, jasmine, and a touch of white mushroom**. There's a gentle roundness on the palate, layered with quiet complexity and a clean, stony finish. Still in its adolescence, this wine hints at depth yet to come—best revisited after 2028 to fully appreciate its unfolding character.

**BEAUNE 1ER CRU
"VIGNES FRANCHES"**

A luxurious, heady nose brims with **violets, rose petals, wild strawberry, and black cherry**—enticing and aromatic. Juicy on the palate, with just enough plush tannins to support a **dark berry midpalate**, accented by **white pepper and fresh thyme**. **Soft clove and black tea** trail along the finish. Approachable now, it promises cellaring potential well through 2035+.

**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
1ER CRU**

The nose is intensely perfumed, with **acacia, wild white flowers, Bosc pear, peach blossom, honeysuckle, and stone**. On the palate, it's surprisingly light yet textured, with notes of **apple skin, lemongrass, white mushroom, white peppercorn, and a tea leaf** finish. Dynamic and vibrant now, it will develop further with additional time in bottle.

**PULIGNY-MONTRACHET
1ER CRU "SOUS LE PUIITS"**

Delicate and precise, the nose offers **wild yellow citrus pith, chamomile, wild flowers, and fresh almond** so refined it borders on the perfumed. The palate is harmonious, with balanced texture and bright acidity. This wine is showing beautifully now.

**MONTAGNY 1ER CRU
"LA GRANDE ROCHE"**

Muddled bosc pear and wet hay aromas lift from the glass accented by a smattering of **dried white blossom**. The neatly-arranged palate sits around a campfire of orchard fruit encircled by **honeysuckle and lemon peel**.
