What made the frost damage so exceptional was that, in many cases, it struck grand cru sites that are rarely affected. "We had frost where we have never had frost-in the grands crus," said Louis-Fabrice Latour, president of Maison Louis Latour.

One issue for vintners was dealing with such small volumes, in some cases minuscule, of grapes and juice. "It was very challenging because the fermentation, aging and bottling process is net equipped to handle such low volumes. It takes more time," says Louis Latour's head winemaker Jean-Charles Thomas.
