Gevrey-Chambertin 2012

Opulent and dense, delivering black cherry, raspberry and earth aromas and flavors. The tannins sneak up, exerting considerable grip on the finish. Fresh, long and concentrated. Best from 2020 through 2036.





Corton Grand Cru Domaine Latour 2012

The cherry, licorice, sandalwood and mineral notes are elegantly displayed in this rich, harmonious red. Flows almost seamlessly now, with a chalky feel on the long finish the only trace of youthfulness. Fine length. Best from 2020 through 2035.





Chambertin Grand Cru Cuvée Héritiers Latour 2012

An intense, minerally style, lean and racy, with cherry, raspberry, tobacco and kirsch flavors. Saturated, tannic and balanced, featuring a long, palate-staining finish. Best from 2020 through 2035.





Charmes- Chambertin Grand Cru 2012

Black cherry, raspberry, mocha and spice flavors gather steam as this builds to a long, fruit-stained finish. Combines power and elegance, intensity and focus, leaving an aftertaste of kirsch, mineral and spice. Best from 2019 through 2033.
