**Corton Grand Cru  
“Clos de la Vigne au Saint”  
2015**

“A concentrated core of pure cherry, raspberry and spice flavors highlights this intense red. Mineral and leafy tobacco elements add depth as this unfolds, while a firm, dusty matrix of tannins provides grip. Stays vibrant and long, with a terrific aftertaste of fruit, spice and mineral.”

**Château Corton Grancey  
Grand Cru 2015**

“A rich style, sporting cherry, raspberry, spice and earth flavors. Moderate tannins lend support, while the flavors persist on the long finish. Though balanced overall, this tightens up at the end, suggesting that the best is yet to come.”

**Corton Grand Cru  
Clos du Roi 2015**

“This is ripe, with black cherry, plum and spice flavors and a fleshy texture, all backed by a solid structure. The flesh buffers the tannins up front, but they win out in the end. Long and well-proportioned, with a vibrant, fresh finish that evokes tobacco.”

**Corton Grand Cru  
“Perrières” 2015**

“Bright cherry, black currant, blueberry and spice flavors ply this dense, juicy red. There is also a firm, tannic side that will need time to integrate. With air, more fruit emerges and the tannins are tamed somewhat. Offers a long, firm finish.”



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**Corton-Charlemagne  
Grand Cru 2015**

“Vanilla, clove and toast notes shade the core flavors of apple, melon and stone in this rangy white. Balanced in a broad-shouldered way, this offers echoes of mineral and spice on the long finish.”

**Volnay 1er Cru  
“En Chevret” 2015**

“A round profile embraces rose, cherry, raspberry and kirsch flavors. Complex and silky, giving way to firm tannins on the finish, leaving a lightly astringent feel.”

**Pommard 1er Cru  
“Epenots” 2015**

This red is expressive, exuding violet, black cherry, blackberry, spice and mineral aromas and flavors, with ample grip. Balanced, staying long and complex on the aftertaste.
