- BARRELS Louis Latour cooperage, French oak, medium toasted

Description

The village of Pernand-Vergeleses is located just 3km from that of Aloxe-Corton and of all the villages that the Grand Cru hill of Corton looks over, this is the most picturesque. The vineyard of « Ile des Vergelleses » is relatively high up on the slope and enjoys a northeasterly exposure, which means that the fruit achieves maximum ripeness quite late on. Our Pernand-Vergeleses "Ile des Vergelleses" is worked traditionally by the winemakers of Domaine Louis Latour.

- TASTING NOTE Ruby red coloured with a powerful yet elegant nose of cherries, this 2010 Pernand-Vergeleses 1er cru "Ile de Vergelleses" is rich and supple in the mouth. A very balanced wine with great structure.
- CELLARING POTENTIAL 7-10 years
- FOOD PAIRING Game birds - poultry - mature cheeses
- SERVING TEMPERATURE 15-17°
